What is the CAC?

The Community Advisory Committee (CAC) is a group of parents and educators interested in helping children who have special educational needs. Our CAC represents eleven school districts* in Santa Clara County. We meet once a month during the school year and work with school district staff and administration to promote our children's needs and educate parents in our districts.

Why should I join the email list?

If your child has an IEP (Individualized Education Plan) or is in Special Education classes, then our group is for you. You'll receive announcements for interesting speakers and panel discussions focused on the special needs of your child and helping you better understand the educational needs of your child. You'll also be informed of other important events and resources.

What's in it for me?

The CAC is where parents like you come together to:

- Meet other parents who face challenges similar to yours
- Provide input to special education directors and school superintendents
- Exchange information and share "tribal knowledge"
- Help set priorities for workshop topics and other resources
