Need help with school work? **Opposing Viewpoints** is a database for social issues that include pro/con viewpoints, reference articles, and more. **CultureGrams** is a great resource that has geographical information for 200+ countries. Get homework help with **Brainfuse**, an online service that offers live tutoring, test preparation and writing assistance. There's also **LearningExpress Library**, which offers reading, writing and math help in both English and Spanish.

There are more great resources available to your student with the eAccount. Go to [student.sccl.org](http://student.sccl.org) and enter your account number. Student accounts are created using the Student ID and school district initials in this format:

S \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ SUSD

The pin number is your birth month and birth day, for example May 1 is 0501.

When the library re-opens, your student can also upgrade to a full-use card that lets you check out books, movies, video games and other items. Please bring along one of the following for identification:

- Any postmarked mail addressed the you, the student
- Your student ID card
