Key Points of the Student Responsible Use of Technology Policy (SRUTP)

Purpose: To provide students with educational tools to be successful, and to teach students appropriate use of technology.

<p>1. District ownership: Use of all district issued accounts, equipment, and network are for school purposes only (assignments, homework, communicating with staff).</p> <p>a. For non-school communication, use personal accounts, equipment, and network.</p> 	<p>2. There is no privacy: Student activity is monitored by different personnel (teacher, principal, director of technology).</p> <p>a. Sharing of Google Docs with inappropriate content is monitored.</p> <p>b. To comply with federal and state laws, inappropriate web activity is filtered and a notification is sent to staff.</p> 
<p>3. Cyberbullying is against the law: Students may be subject to discipline for off-campus misconduct if the misconduct creates a hostile learning environment or is reasonably likely to cause a substantial disruption to school activity. “Bullying’ means any severe or pervasive physical or verbal act or conduct, including communications made in writing or by means of an electronic act, and including one or more acts committed by a pupil or group of pupils as defined in [Education Code] section 48900.2, 48900.3, or 48900.4, directed toward one or more pupils that has or can be reasonably predicted to have harmful effects.</p> 	<p>4. Appropriate Use: I will notify my teacher if I need any help in using technology appropriately.</p>
