**Key Points of the Student Responsible Use of Technology Policy (SRUTP)**  
**Extracted from the SRUTP**

**Purpose:** To provide students with educational tools to be successful, and to teach students appropriate use of technology.

<p><b>1. District ownership:</b> Use of all district issued accounts, equipment, and network are for school purposes only (assignments, homework, communicating with staff).</p> <p>a. For non-school communication, use personal accounts, equipment, and network.</p> 	<p><b>2. There is no privacy:</b> Student activity is monitored by different personnel (teacher, principal, director of technology).</p> <p>a. Sharing of Google Docs with inappropriate content is monitored.</p> <p>b. To comply with federal and state laws, inappropriate web activity is filtered and a notification is sent to staff.</p> 
<p><b>3. Cyberbullying is against the law:</b> Students may be subject to discipline for off-campus misconduct if the misconduct is related to school activity or attendance and causes or is reasonably likely to cause a substantial disruption to school activity.</p> 	<p><b>4. Appropriate Use:</b> I will notify my teacher if I need any help in using technology appropriately.</p>
